ENTER YOUR PROJECT:

You may submit just one entry.

- After registration you can enter your proposal until **1st of August 2021 at 12PM**
- Language has to be English
- The entry shall be named **with registration ID**
- Max 3 pages A3 standing format submission as PDF file
- All pages shall in top right corner have the written registration ID

THE PROJECT MUST CONTAIN FOLLOWING:

- Name of chair
- Short description in English of the concept/project. Max 300 words
- Sketches showing the creative process
- Images explaining the project. Can be photographs of models, drawings, computer renderings
- Eventual other explanatory material as images of colors, material, fittings, details etc.


