## What Is A BIP?

A blended intensive programme (BIP), funded by the Erasmus+ Programme, is implemented by at least 3 higher education institutions (HEIs) from at least 3 Programme Countries. BIPs should encourage transdisciplinary and multinational teaching and training.

**Short-term physical group mobility** abroad  
minimum 5 maximum 30 days



Compulsory **virtual component**  
before, during and/or after the mobility



Minimum **3 HEIs** from 3 programme countries  
Minimum **15 participants**  
Minimum **3 ECTS** credits



# Participation

- **Who can participate:**
  - ❖ Undergraduate, Master's and PhD students in the BIP's areas of specialisation, i.e., Portuguese as a Foreign/Second Language
  - ❖ Lecturers, teachers and trainers from HEIs in Erasmus+ Programme Countries
- **Funding: Erasmus+ KA131 funds from sending HEI**
  - ❖ Erasmus+ funding can only be awarded to participants (students and staff) from Programme countries
  - ❖ Students: minimum 5 course days plus 2 travel days (€70/day)  
= €490/student
  - ❖ Teachers/trainers: Erasmus+ Staff Mobility for Training rules apply (country-specific daily rate x course days + 2 travel days + country travel band)

# Teaching Portuguese as a Non-Native Language: Sharing Experiences, Multiplying Resources

- **Dates:**
  - ❖ Online: 5 and 6<sup>th</sup> June 2023
  - ❖ Physical: 12<sup>th</sup> to 16<sup>th</sup> June 2023 (plus two travel days)
- **Description:** The course arises from the intersection of different institutions where Portuguese is taught as a non-native language and is thus inspired by a diversity of teaching and learning experiences. The existence of extensive inter-university relationships around the teaching of Portuguese (PFL) has allowed us to organise a network that will work together in this BIP to multiply the resources that each participating institution has created over the years.
